

Two AH-stores nearly empty due to conflict

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Albert Heijn has stopped stocking two stores in Leiden and Berghem. The reason is a conflict with franchisee Gerrit van Noort.

The reason is disagreement over 'financial obligations', so that a spokesman for Albert Heijn tells the [Brabants Dagblad](#). "Despite all efforts, it is unfortunately not possible to reach an agreement at this moment." The stores have not been stocked since Sunday and the shelves are now almost empty, but the stores are still open.

It concerns the stores at the Kooiplein in Leiden and the Sint Willibrordusstraat in Berghem. The store in Berghem organized a weekend game for children in the empty store. It is not yet clear when the stores will be restocked.
